Registration and Payment Information

Students are encouraged to register as soon as possible, since enrollment is limited. Once the maximum enrollment is reached, additional students cannot be added to the course. You may register for this class by contacting the MATC international education office (see information below).

Once your registration is complete, you will receive information from the college regarding payment of tuition and fees. Upon registering, you will also receive additional travel documentation for the trip to Costa Rica. Students will be responsible for their own air travel to and from Costa Rica. Students are encouraged to make travel arrangements as soon as possible since airfare costs may increase nearer the date of the trip.
